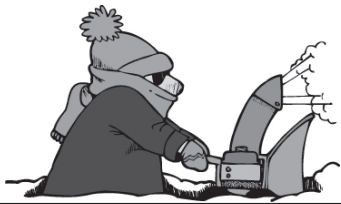


## SNOW REMOVAL

## Fire Department News

Last year, more than 16,000 Ohio families found out first-hand the devastation that fire can cause. Smoke and fire killed 130 people - half of whom could have been saved had their homes been equipped with working smoke detectors.

### What can you do to increase your odds in surviving a residential fire?

1. Test your smoke detector monthly - make the first Tuesday of the month test day.
2. Change the batteries in your smoke detectors twice yearly. (Change Your Clock, Change Your Battery)
3. Install a smoke detector on each level of your home and inside sleeping areas.
4. Familiarize children with the sound of your smoke detectors.
5. Have a working smoke detector on every level of your home and inside all occupied sleeping areas.
6. Have a home fire escape plan and practice it.

The Leroy Township Fire Department is joining the State Fire Marshal and the United States Fire Administration in asking all residents of Leroy to install, maintain and test their smoke detectors monthly.

If you are unable to purchase, install or maintain your smoke detector, the Fire Department will provide smoke detectors, free of charge, and install them, if necessary, at no cost to you through our community smoke detector program.

## Mailbox Replacement Policy

*The Leroy Township Trustees have adopted the following mailbox replacement policy as follows:*

Mailboxes damaged by **DIRECT** contact with a vehicle or its plow blade while performing Township maintenance operations will be repaired or replaced with a 4 x 4 treated wooden post and a mailbox approved by the United States Postal Service. **Damage by thrown or pushed snow does not warrant replacement.** In the event that the mailbox is of a specialty or exotic type of construction, the Township's liability per occurrence is limited to a mailbox unit as described above or a cash settlement not to exceed \$35.00. An inspection of the damaged mailbox by the Leroy Township Road Dept. superintendent or assistant superintendent is required prior to replacement or payment.
