LAKE COUNTY CONFIRMS FIRST RABID BAT FOR 2010

The Lake County General Health District has received information that a bat from Concord was recently confirmed to be rabid by the Ohio Department of Health. No known bite occurred from the incident; however, the homeowners are taking necessary precautions and are receiving post-exposure prophylaxis. This is the first rabid bat found in Lake County in 2010 and the 26th rabid bat found in Lake County since 1971. There have been 34 rabid bats found in Ohio this year.

Bats are beneficial as they eat large numbers of flying insects, but bats may also be a source of rabies. Humans and pets are exposed to the rabies virus when they are either bitten or scratched by an infected animal; or less commonly, when saliva from an infected animal gets into an open wound or mucous membrane. In the case of a known exposure to a bat, or if a bat is discovered in the house while residents are sleeping, the bat should be carefully captured and the Health District contacted to determine if the bat should be

Lake County residents are reminded about the mandatory rabies vaccination law for ALL DOGS, CATS, and FERRETS over four months of age. This requirement also applies to indoor pets because, in some instances, a potentially rabid animal (especially bats) may get into the house. As a result, it is important for pet owners to have their pets regularly vaccinated against rabies and always keep the shots up-to-date. Vaccinating pets against rabies protects the pet, as well as family members, against the threat of this fatal disease.

Paine Cemetery established in 1828 will receive a dedication plaque. Thanks to the diligent record keeping of the Lake County Genealogical Society and hard work of many of the LeRoy Township employees, a bronze plague will be erected depicting the documented names of LeRoy Township residents and the unknowns who lie in rest in Paine Hollow, Nighman Cemetery. The cemetery was established in 1828; however, the first burial recorded is 1820. There are three documented veterans buried at the cemetery. Two are from the Civil War (GAR) and the other a revolutionary war soldier (Sons of the American Revolution). As noted for the Lake County Genealogical Society, Henry Paine was buried here, but when his wife died years later, his remains were exhumed and laid to rest again next to his wife at Evergreen Cemetery in Painesville. Weather, vandalism, and time have not been kind to this historical cemetery, but now the names and memories of those buried there can be acknowledged.


Annual Tree Lighting Ceremony Sunday, December 5, 2010 7:00 P.M.

Please HELP Us Fix Our Roads!

We are in dire need of additional funds to patch, seal coat, maintain and repair our roads. The funds we receive from our 1.5 mil road levy can be stretched no further. With the tripled cost of tar, limestone, and dust control we CANNOT maintain our roads. There are many pot holes and large cracks which we won't be able to fill, or seal coat over.


We know times are tough for everyone. We are asking for as little as possible to have a 5 year maintenance plan for all of our roads. Currently we are only able to "band aid" the worst areas. A 0 .9 mil levy, a little less than one mil would bring us in approximately \$87,000.00. This money would be used for purchase of materials ONLY for maintenance and repair of our township roads. With passage of this levy we will start in 2011 with our 5 year road maintenance plan.

The owner of a \$100,000.00 TAX VALUE home will pay only \$27.56 A YEAR for this 0.9 mil levy. Voting day is Tuesday, November 2nd.

STREET LIGHTS:

Please, if you notice a street light burned out in your area of LeRoy Twp.; call the road dept., at 254-4234 with the address for the light so that we can contact CEI to have it fixed. We pay for the area lighting regardless of whether they are working or not. THANK YOU!


