

*LEROY TOWNSHIP TRUSTEE MEETING
MINUTES*

The Leroy Township Trustees met in special session on Friday, May 17, at 5 p.m., at the Leroy Community Room.

Present were: Rich VanPelt, Chairman, Heather Shelton, and Sharon Rodgers Fiscal Officer. Chuck Klco, Trustee was out of town.

Rich VanPelt, chairman opened the meeting.

Guests: None.

The purpose of the meeting was to hold a public hearing on proposed zoning changes as recommended by the Leroy Township Zoning Commission, and approved by the Lake County Planning Commission.

Heather Shelton made a motion to approve zoning changes to definitions, Section 2. Changes to Section 5.2: (fines), Section 16.04.13, delete "household equipment, tools and", changes to Section 21: Fences, 21.04-21.07. Rich VanPelt seconded the motion. Resolution: 19-13. Poll of the vote: VanPelt, aye, Shelton, aye.

At the Fiscal Officer's request, Rich made a motion to approve enrolling the Township in the State's U.A.N. (Uniform Accounting Network), to replace the current O.T.A.S. accounting program which will no longer be supported at the end of this year and to send Julie Himmelman to a two day training class in Columbus. Heather seconded the motion, all were in favor.

At the Fiscal Officer's request, a motion was made by Heather to transfer interest for the month of April in the amount of \$50.24 from general fund into investment fund. Transfer from investment fund into Motor Vehicle, \$6.17, and from General Fund into Gas Tax, \$12.94. Rich VanPelt seconded the motion, all were in favor.

JJJ has applied for a new conditional use permit for Cedar Hills from a "teaching life skills school, to a faith based Christian program focused on educating individuals who have completed a chemical addiction rehabilitation program. If this conditional use permit is approved, they will let their original conditional use permit for a rehabilitation center school for teaching life skills lapse.

There being no further business, Rich made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Heather. All were in favor, meeting adjourned.
