

## LEROY TOWNSHIP TRUSTEE MINUTES

The Leroy Township Trustees met on Tuesday, June 23, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. at the Leroy Township Hall.

**Present were:** Chuck Klco, Rich VanPelt, Heather Shelton, and Julie Himmelman, Fiscal Officer and Ron Graham, attorney.

**Guests:** Attorney, David Smith, legal counsel through OTARMA

Chuck opened the public hearing with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**First Public Hearing:** Chuck opened the public hearing regarding the additional \$5 license tax as authorized by ORC 4504.18. There were no comments from the public for or against. Chuck made a motion to close the public meeting. Heather seconded and all were in favor.

David Smith, the OTARMA legal representation in the claim of John Preston v. Anthony Lilly, et al. (Claim No: OTR019634A2) (File #: 200143) arrived. Heather made a motion to go into executive session. Executive session was closed.

**Second Public Hearing:** Chuck opened the second public hearing at 7:30 p.m. regarding the additional \$5 license tax as authorized by ORC 4504.181. There were no comments from the public for or against. Chuck made a motion to close the public meeting. Heather seconded and all were in favor.

Chuck stated that the AA group asked if they could resume meetings at the community center. The fiscal officer stated that the risk management consultant from OTARMA recommended against having anyone in the community center or the pavilion at this time.

Heather stated that she spoke with Brandy about the Fall Garage Sale. Heather said that she could not decide what individual homeowners should do, but there would be no admittance to the community center and flyers will be available at the pavilion.

Ohio's COVID numbers were discussed.

Chuck made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Heather seconded all were in favor.
