The Leroy Township Trustees met in regular session on April 18, 2011, at 7pm at the Leroy Township Hall.

Department Reports:

ZONING: Don Crellin of the Leroy Twp. Zoning Commission stated the board has been reviewing sections 17 & 18. They also had a general discussion on certain areas within the township and set-backs.

FIRE: The Fire Chief was working. Rich Sr. gave the chief's report. There were 16 calls since the last meeting. YTD, 139. The rear bay door has been repaired. The chief is looking into pricing for a new replacement door for the rear bay. The annual pancake breakfast was a success. Thanks to all that helped and attended that day.

ROAD: No report. The Fiscal Officer stated in reviewing the budget for the road dept. and discussion with the road supervisor, a "no gas" Fridays plan may be implemented. This means all road work and using of equipment will only be done Monday-Thursday, and all garage, office and yard work done on Fridays as a way of conserving fuel and trying to cut costs.

The annual meeting with the County Engineer was held. The upcoming projects, replacement of Vrooman Rd. bridge and upgrades will be bid out 2012, and started in 2013. The Round-a-bout for 5-points will be applied for thru Issue II funding in 2011 and if received would not start until 2012.

CEMETERIES: The corrected maps for Vrooman Rd. Cemetery have been sent back to Burrows Consulting for the on-line mapping program. Gerri reported 4 funerals so far this year, three burials, 1 cremation.

PARKS: Linda stated the annual Easter egg hunt was well attended. Leroy polo shirts can be purchased at the Leroy Country store, or thru any member of the recreation board. Linda is also working on new bi-laws for the rec. board and will review them once Chuck has returned **OLD BUSINESS**:

NEW BUSINESS: Linda reported that it appears part of Senate Bill 5 would require all employees to pay 15% of their health care costs. Also the employee portion of OPERS will also be increased. Implementation of this is still a long way off.
