## LEROY TOWNSHIP TRUSTEE MEETING MINITES

The Leroy Township Trustees met in special session on Monday, July 28<sup>th</sup> at 7 p.m. at the Leroy Township Hall.

Present were: Rich VanPelt, Chuck Klco, Heather Shelton, and Sharon Rodgers.

Rich VanPelt opened the meeting with the pledge to the flag.

**Guests:** Patrick, of Precision Woodworking talked to the Trustees about repairs to the meeting house. It would involve repairing some of the siding, repairing the pediment, and probably replacing some of the siding. It would cost a minimum of \$5,000.00 to replace the doors. He stated we could consider using wood from an old building that is being torn down. The Trustees thanked him for his time and said they will get back to him. There is a lot to consider with this building. Heather has the application for the Ohio Grant. Precision woodworking gave a quote for \$5,394.00, for mainly trim replace/repair work.

Chuck made a motion to put a 0.90 mill continuous road repair levy on the November 4<sup>th</sup> ballot. This levy, if approved will bring in approximately \$84,000.00 per year, which will be used for road repairs only. Cost to the average taxpayer is \$31.50 per year. Our roads are in bad need of repair, and we do not have enough money to repair them. Rich 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Poll of the vote: VanPelt, aye, Klco, aye, Shelton, aye. Resolution 14-16

Chuck made a motion to hire Rich VanPelt, Jr. to mow our cemeteries until the end of mowing season. This is a part-time seasonal job only, paying \$7.85/hr. Heather seconded the motion. Rich Sr. abstained.

Heather stated she would like to investigate hiring outside contract work to mow our cemeteries next year, or at least compare the costs.

Motion by Chuck to pay all bills, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Heather, all in favor.

Motion to adjourn by Chuck 2<sup>nd</sup> by Heather, meeting adjourned.
