School is out, summer is here! Now, what to do? There are a lot of fun places and activities in our own Lake County. From beaches, to parks, river fishing, summer concerts, festivals, events, summer camps, and summer reading; there is always something to do! The next several months, our newsletter will focus on summer enjoyment, activities, events and fun!

Summer Camps

Painesville Recreation Department's Summer Day Camp is for children ages 6-13 (they will accept 5 year olds who have completed Kindergarten). From May 28th to August 2nd the camp day is from 8:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m., with extended hours available for additional cost. The cost of the camp is \$160/week for city residents and \$175/week for nonresidents. This price includes all trips and 2 camp shirts. Lunch is provided by The Lunch Box Program through Painesville City Local Schools. Camp discounts are available for siblings. Some of the activities include visiting local Metroparks, recreation park activities, Painesville Splash Pad, camp activities and field trips.

The **City of Mentor Parks and Recreation** has traditional camps, sports camps, and discovery camps. Civic Center day camps, beginner to advanced level sports camps for fencing, golf, volleyball, cheerleading, ice skating, basketball, and soccer are offered. There are boating camps, a week at the beach, X-treme science, artists, superhero academy, theater, crafts, quests, cooking, and grandparent and me camps. Register online at cityofmentor.com.

YMCA Camp 2024. Ages 5-12, must have completed kindergarten. Campers are offered age-appropriate themes, crafts, games, and more to introduce, experience, challenge and explore the fun and life-building skills and development of camping. From June 3 through August 6, the schedule will vary weekly, with possible visits to the outdoor Y, Fairport Harbor Beach, Cleveland Metroparks Zoo, Pioneer Waterland, and more.
