FISCAL:

Rich made a motion to pay all bills. Jason 2nd. All in favor. Motion passed.

FIRE:

Rich asked for the adoption of <u>RESOLUTION 25-26</u> to place the old fire truck 2413on Gov Deals for sale. Poll the vote.

ROADS:

Equipment storage is inadequate due to high costs for new garage construction and septic system requirements.

Some road repairs remain unfinished due to budget constraints; projects are prioritized by traffic count and urgency.

Ditching continues as an ongoing maintenance task, with priorities set by immediate needs (e.g., flooding).

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Nine cemetery plots have been sold this year with seven burials.

New section markers are being considered for easier navigation in Williams Cemetery.

PARKS:

Jason brought quotes to repair baseball benches ranged from \$2,400 to \$3,200. Jason made a motion to approve the quote for \$2,400.

Rich 2nd.

All in favor.

Plans for a new electronic community sign were discussed; a \$6,200 grant is available, but the full cost is ~\$30,000 and trustees expressed concerns about the expense. Discussion tabled until next meeting.

Township garage sale and Trick or Treat Stroll scheduled; candy donations accepted at the fire station. Residents can set up tables for events by contacting organizers in advance.

ZONING:

Temporary signs do not require permits unless placed in prohibited locations like roundabouts.

Unapproved advertising signs on telephone poles are not allowed and are removed.

The rundown property at the roundabout is unresolved due to ongoing litigation and bankruptcy issues.
